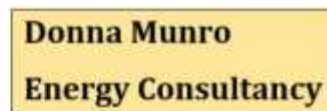

Grants

Grants are available to help you implement actual carbon reduction measures. They can contribute towards the cost of activities or the purchase of equipment and capital works that will support the decarbonisation of your organisation.

The total grant funding pot is £65,000 in 2023/24 and £150,000 in 2024/25. Capital or revenue grants of up to £10,000 are available per organisation, and grants of more than £3,000 require a 30% match contribution.
